Notes:

- *In each of these cases, 1-2 graduates' certification is pending.
- NA--A number of our graduates do not intend to certify in NYS, and get certified and take positions elsewhere. For example, of the 14 CEDU graduates in 2016-2017, 57% certified in other states.
- Please note that candidates are required to submit their edTPA (a New York State requirement for certification) *on their own*, so that candidates who wait longer to do so take longer to get certified.

Highlights

- Over the past three years, 100% of graduates (aside from a few pending) who applied for New York State teaching certification were successful in obtaining certification.
