Graduation Rate: 66% of all full-time undergraduate students graduate within 6 years of starting their education as first-time freshman at Wagner College.

Loan Default Rate: Wagner College's three-year cohort default rate is 3.0%. The national three-year cohort default rate is 11.8%.

Median Borrowing: Wagner College students typically borrow \$27,000 in federal loans for their undergraduate study. A typical monthly payment for a loan which has a 10-year repayment term is \$277.10 per month.

Estimated Costs:

All costs listed are estimated costs based upon full-time enrollment for residential students and will be finalized after the Board of Trustees votes on tuition and fee rates each year for the upcoming academic year.

Wagner College offers various degree programs. Costs of attendance for programs may vary by factors such as major, enrollment status, housing status. All figures are subject to change.
