ELIGIBILITY: All Wagner College faculty, staff and students, departments as well as community partners.

AWARD CRITERIA:

The award recognizes and honors an exceptional individual, department or community partner who exemplifies a sense of caring and responsibility for others that connects citizens and works to address community problems. The awardees give their time to community activities, inspiring others to serve and acts as a role model while improving the lives of others. One winner from each category (faculty, staff, student, department and community partner) will be chosen. **Award winners will be announced at Civic Engagement Recognition Day festivities on April 19, 2012 at 4:15 pm in the Manzulli Board Room in Foundation Hall. Awardees will receive a commemorative plaque and cash award.**

NOMINATING PROCEDURE

General Background: Anyone may nominate, and self-nominations are welcome. Major elements of a nominee's contributions will include: the amount of time spent volunteering and performing community service; the level of effort expended; initiative demonstrated; quality and overall impact of the work performed. Equally significant will be the personal responsibility and positive attitude displayed toward volunteerism and community service and the level of cooperation with others in the community.
