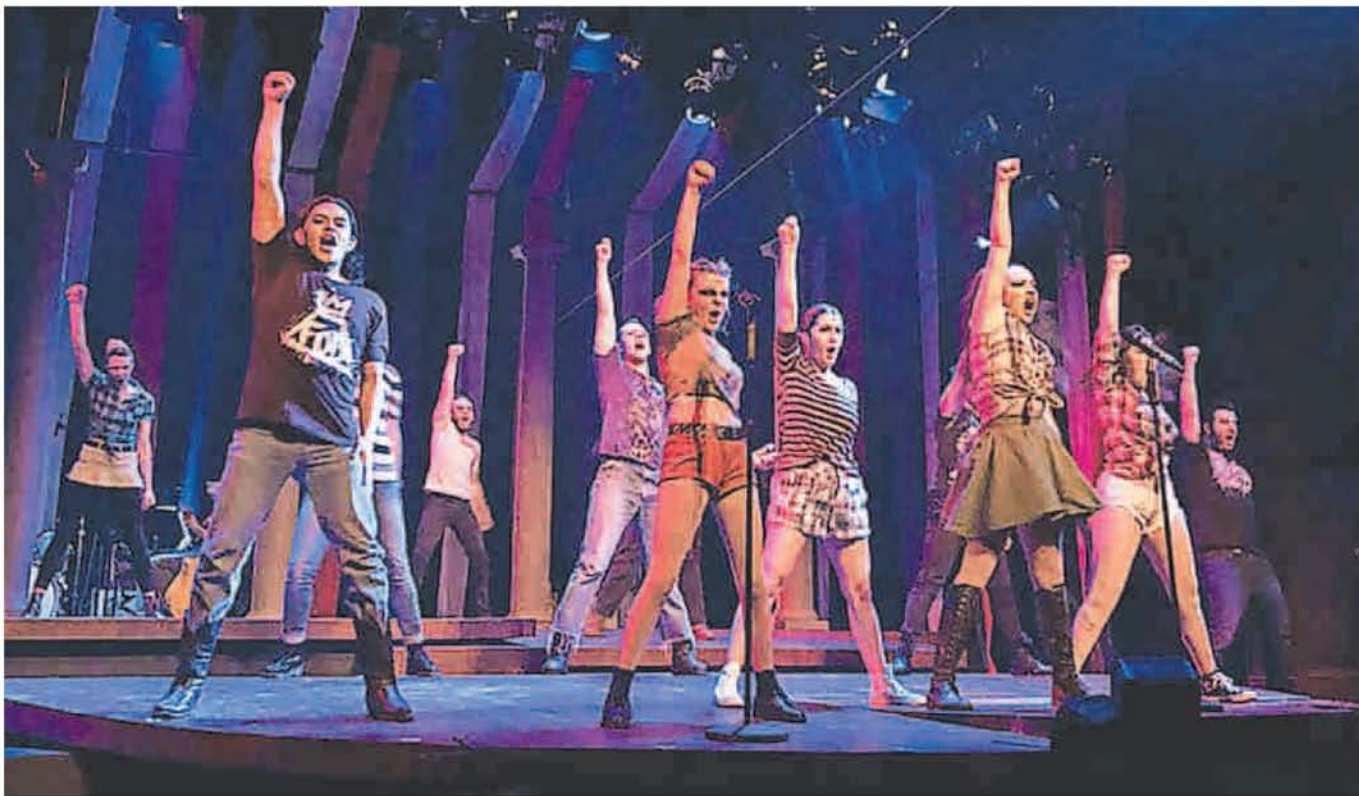
'Bloody, Bloody Andrew Jackson'
