### GREEK STANDARDS ACCREDITATION LEVELS

#### Gold Chapter

---

**180-200 points (90%-100%)**

*This rating is assigned to organizations that have completed all requirements and exceeded the expectations of the committee. To maintain good standing, organizations must complete a re-accreditation process each semester.*

These organizations may:

- Apply for consideration for Chapter of the Year
- Apply for funding from the Office of Co-Curricular Programs to support leadership development (conference attendance, guest speakers, etc.) or programmatic efforts
- Host both philanthropic and social events
- Participate in rush and/or recruitment activities
- Participate in Housing Lottery to reside as an affinity group and have access to an organization lounge in Parker Towers Residence Hall.
- Participate fully in Songfest and Homecoming activities

#### Silver Chapter

---

**160-179 points (80%-89.5%)**

*This rating is assigned to organizations that have completed all requirements and met the expectations of the committee. To maintain good standing, organizations must complete a re-accreditation process each semester.*

These organizations may:

- Host both philanthropic and social events
- Participate in rush and/or recruitment activities
- Participate in Housing Lottery to reside as an affinity group and have access to an organization lounge in Parker Towers Residence Hall.
- Participate fully in Songfest and Homecoming activities

## Bronze Chapter

---

**140-159 points (70%-79.5%)**

*This rating is assigned to organizations that have completed all requirements and met the expectations of the committee. To maintain good standing, organizations must complete a re-accreditation process each semester,*

These organizations may:

- Host both philanthropic and social events
- Participate in rush and/or recruitment activities
- Participate in Housing Lottery to reside as an affinity group and have access to an organization lounge in Parker Towers Residence Hall.
- May participate in Songfest

These organizations **may not**:

- May not host Royal Court candidates for Songfest or Homecoming.

## Chapter on Warning

---

**120-139 points (60%-69.5%)**

*This rating is assigned to organizations that have completed some requirements and some of the expectations of the committee with reservations. To return to good standing, organizations must complete a semesterly re-accreditation process. Additionally organizations with this rating must work with the Office of Co-Curricular Programs to create an action plan to improve their rating. Organizations will be required to attend additional workshops created to address their deficiencies and to meet bi-weekly with staff members in the Office of Co-Curricular Programs. Be advised that organizations that maintain this status for two consecutive semesters will lose their accreditation and privileges afforded a Greek organization at Wagner College.*

Organizations on warning **may**:

- Participate in rush and/or recruitment activities
- Participate in Housing Lottery to reside as an affinity group and have access to an organization lounge in Parker Towers Residence Hall.
- Host only one social event each semester

Organizations on warning **may not**:

- Participate in Songfest, and may not host Royal Court candidates for Songfest or Homecoming.

# No Accreditation

---

## 119 points or less (59.5% or below)

*This rating is assigned to organizations that have not met the standards as determined by the committee. These organizations will not be permitted to function as a registered student organization at Wagner College for the period of one semester. During this year organization may **not**:*

- Host any events on or off campus
- Participate in rush and/or recruitment activities
- Participate in Housing Lottery to reside as an affinity group
- Have access to an organization lounge in Parker Towers Residence Hall

*Further these organizations must work with the Office of Co-Curricular Program to create an action plan to improve their rating. Organizations will be required to attend additional workshops created to address their deficiencies and to meet weekly with staff members in the Office of Co-Curricular Programs. Be advised that organizations that maintain this status for two consecutive semesters may lose their charter and not be allowed to re-charter at Wagner College for a period of 10 years.*
