

**CURRICULUM SUMMARY SHEET
MINOR IN EDUCATIONAL STUDIES**

CONCENTRATIONS: CHILDHOOD EDUCATION 1-6 or ADOLESCENT EDUCATION 7-12

Wagner students with a minor in educational studies are eligible to receive graduate credit for an articulated accelerated Master's degree in Childhood Education or Adolescent Education. Upon completion of the masters program, students qualify for college recommendation for initial and professional New York State Certification in Childhood/Students with Disabilities (1-6) or Adolescent/Students with Disabilities (7-12) within the specific content area of study.

Candidates wishing to pursue the accelerated masters program should meet early in their undergraduate careers, preferably by the sophomore year, for advisement on requirements for certification and, for secondary education, on specific coursework required for certification in the subject area.

3.0 GPA overall and in the major, in addition to a B or better in all Education coursework, is required.
