

Prospective students unable to attend Wagner College Theatre's Audition Day may submit a video audition. Auditioning via video submission will neither improve nor lessen the chances of being accepted into the program.

The audition recording must be received by Monday February 11, 2019

- Record (in one uninterrupted take) a 16-bar selection from a Broadway musical, a sixty to ninety second monologue, and a personal statement.
- Record a demonstration of your dance/movement abilities.
- Do not exceed the time and length limits.
- Use minimal sets and few props, and only if necessary.
- Dress as you would for an audition, rather than in costume.
- Present work that you believe demonstrates your best abilities. We want to see you in the audition video.

Recording Guidelines:

- 1. Start the recording device. 2
- 2. Introduce yourself (give your full name). 2
- 3. Introduce the song you will be singing. 2
- 4. Introduce the monologue you are presenting and name the author of the ②piece. Please do not explain the scene. ②
- 5. Take your place, cue the musical accompaniment, and begin. 2
- When you have finished singing the song, continue recording (Do not stop the recording device) and begin your monologue.
- 7. When you have completed your monologue continue recording, and tell us in your own words why Wagner College Theatre is of interest to you and why you want to commit the next four years of your life to this training. You may stop recording at this point.
- 8. In your second video you will present your dance/movement demonstration. You may include more than one piece to show different styles. Limit each selection to one minute in length.
