

Suggestion for web pages for faculty advising:

Got to the Registrar Office webpage (in the left column):

Window 1: Registration (has ILC, special topics, times to register, and general information specific to the term)

Window 2: Academic information, then **Advisement** (has Course Bulletin catalog, CACE sheets for the major and FAQ's)

Window 3: Open MyWagner, go to Faculty/Advisor, then **Student Advising**, pick an advisee (has Unofficial Transcript, when accessed, has a PDF at the bottom for a transfer credit and its evaluation), also there is their Degree Audit which is only OPEN to faculty advisor for quick check.
