# HOUSING APPLICATION

## How to Complete the 2020-2021 Housing Application

- ✈ Go to [housing.wagner.edu](https://housing.wagner.edu)
- ✈ Login using `firstname.lastname` and your all-access password
- ✈ Go to 'Manage Applications' and choose Fall 2020 application
- ✈ Fill out ALL sections and click 'Submit'

## Due Dates:

- ✈ February 18<sup>th</sup>: Housing Application Priority Deadline & Raffle Due
- ✈ February 23<sup>rd</sup>: Housing Application Deadline

# HOUSING SELECTION STEP BY STEP

- ✈ Complete Fall 2020 Housing Application by February 18th
- ✈ Students are randomly assigned a Lottery Number based on class year
  - ✈ Lottery Numbers are sent out via email on March 4th
- ✈ Students complete a Housing Group Form with their roommates for next year
- ✈ Students attend the appropriate Housing Selection Night, bring their Housing Group Form and select their room with Res Ed staff members

# SELECTION NIGHT: WHAT HAPPENS?

- ✈ Students come to their appropriate housing selection night at 5pm with the complete Housing Group Form
- ✈ While students wait, available rooms will be projected so students can track what rooms are available
- ✈ Lottery numbers will be called & students will meet with Res Ed staff members who will place students. Students will have 30 seconds to select the room they want
- ✈ For groups, the student with the lowest lottery number picks for the entire group (note: this only would occur if all students in a group are eligible to select)

# LOTTERY NUMBERS

- ✈ Once students apply for housing, everyone is broken up into categories based on completed units as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>
  - ✈ These categories are Graduate Students, Rising Seniors, Rising Juniors & Rising Sophomores
- ✈ Lottery numbers are randomly assigned per categories. Lottery numbers have NO correlation to a students' registration status with class selection.
- ✈ Lottery numbers are as follows:
  - ✈ Graduate students & Rising Seniors: 001-400
  - ✈ Rising Juniors: 401-800
  - ✈ Rising Sophomores: 801-1300

# SELECTION DATE BREAKDOWN

✈ Monday, March 9<sup>th</sup>: Rising Senior & Grad Night

✈ Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>: Rising Senior/Grad + Rising Junior MIXED Night

✈ Wednesday, March 11<sup>th</sup>: Rising Junior Night

✈ Thursday, March 12<sup>th</sup>: Rising Sophomore Night *AND* Rising Senior + Rising Junior + Rising Sophomore MIXED Night

# WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

## ✈ Guild Hall

✈ All of the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor

✈ Most of the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor

✈ 4<sup>th</sup> floor closed for Honors Community

## ✈ Foundation Hall

✈ Entire building is open minus a select few traditional suites and single rooms!

## ✈ Towers Hall

✈ The following floors are offline for Theme/Greek Communities or closures:  
A1, A2, A4, B6, C1, C4, C6, & E Tower

# TYPES OF ROOMS

## Towers Hall

Single: 1 occupant

Double: 2 occupants

Suite: 2 bedrooms w/ a common space; 4 occupants

## Guild Hall

Suite: 2 bedrooms joined by a shared bathroom; 4 occupants

## Foundation Hall

Suite: 2 bedrooms; 4 occupants

Seahawk Suite: 2 bedrooms w/ a common space; 4 occupants

## REMEMBER

Students must select 4 person suites in Guild, Towers, and Foundation in a complete group of 4!

Students can select doubles in Towers as a group of 2 or will be consolidated with another solo applicant.



# GROUP TYPES

- ✈ Double or 4 person suite (same class year): Pick on your appropriate rising class year night
- ✈ Double or 4 person suite (different class years): Pick on your appropriate mixed night
- ✈ Incomplete Group: If you are missing one individual to fill a double, you will be allowed to pick a room, but you will be consolidated.  
*Suites CANNOT pick without complete groups.*
- ✈ Single: You will pick on last chance lotto selection

# HOUSING RAFFLE

- ✈ If you submit your housing application by February 18<sup>th</sup>, you are entered to win one of the following:
  - ✈ A guaranteed Seahawk Suite (Rising Seniors only)
  - ✈ A guaranteed Foundation Suite (Rising Seniors & Rising Juniors only)
  - ✈ A guaranteed Towers Suite (Rising Seniors & Rising Juniors only)
  - ✈ A guaranteed Guild Suite & a guaranteed Towers Suite (one awarded to the top lottery slot for each class year)
- ✈ Students will be notified prior to housing selection if they have won.
- ✈ Students **MUST** be able to fill a suite completely if they win.
