Executive Board Roles

The Executive Board of the Student Government provides oversight to the entire student government, works collaboratively with other Senators and Class Presidents, and are the chief student liaisons. Here is a description of each position on the elected executive board:

Student Government Association President

The SGA President leads the entire student body to execute their vision for a student-centered Wagner. The SGA President leads the executive board, manages the priorities and is the primary student advocate.

Student Government Association Executive Vice President

The SGA Executive Vice President is the primary advisor to the President and works to execute their vision for a student-centered Wagner. The EVP oversees the 4 student senators.

Student Government Association Vice President of Finance

The VP of Finance oversees the SGA finances, including the club/organization funding process and chairs the Student Finance Committee.

Student Government Association Vice President of Organizations

The SGA Vice President of Organizations chairs Club Congress. In their role, the VP of Organizations manages all club additions, changes, and club policies with Student Engagement and Activities.

Student Government Association Vice President of Operations

The SGA VP of Operations is the primary operating officer of the SGA. They are responsible for the internal and external management of the SGA, including overseeing elections, sustainability and PR efforts.

Student Government Association Vice President of Programming

The VP of Programming is the President of WagCab. This person is the primary programming officer of the students and works to make large scale events and offerings a reality.

*Please note, the President and Executive Vice President run on a ticket together. All other roles run independently. However, endorsements and coalitions are permitted.

Finally, there will be 3 presidential appointments to come after elections. If you are interested in these, please reach out. These roles are not elected:

- Parliamentarian
- Sustainability Secretary
- Public Relations Secretary

Class Council Roles

Class President

The Class President serves on the SGA Senate as the formal representative of their class.

Class Vice President

The Class Vice President is the primary advisor to the President and works to executive their vision for a class identity.

Class Treasurer

The Class Treasurer manages the finances for the class council.

Class Secretary

The Class Secretary manages the operations of their class, including meetings and organizing the class council for efficiency.

Election Rules and Guidelines

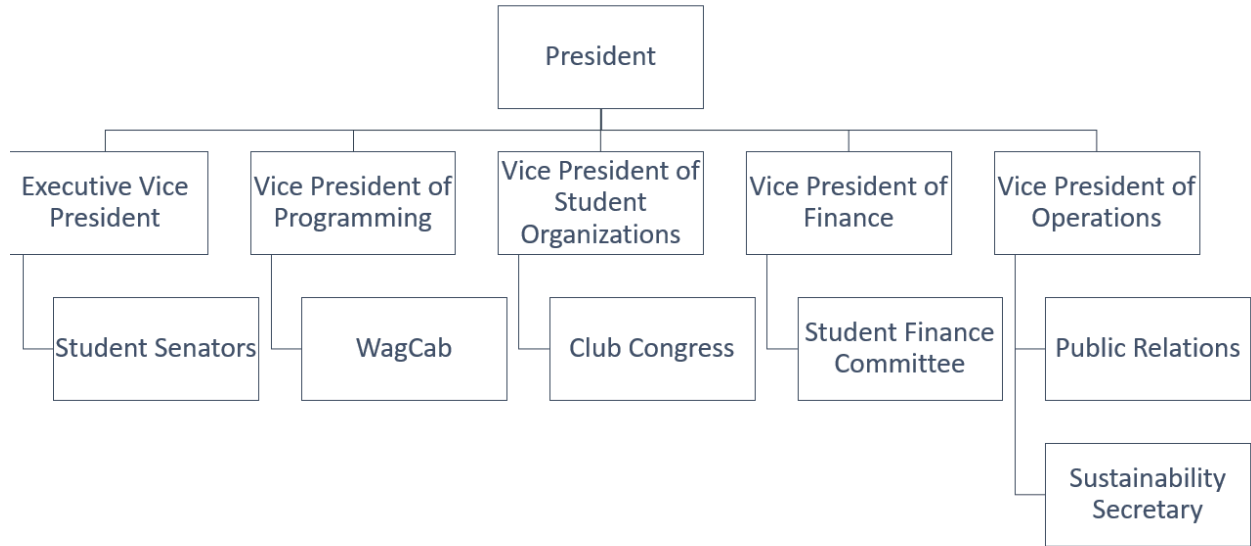
- All campaign material must be approved by the Dean of Campus Life Office and the Office of Student Engagement and Activities.
- No campaign material may slander any other candidate.
- All campaign material must be removed by the closing of poles on the second Election Day.
- All posters must be posted by the Office of Student Engagement and Activities. They may only be posted on bulletin boards or posting locations.
 - Posters may not be posted on doors.
- All candidates have the right to contest elections within 24 hours of the results being posted.
- Results will be generated by the Director of Student Engagement and Activities. The results will be delivered to the Advisors of the Student Government Association who will inform the sitting President and President-Elect.
- Tallies of election results will not be released to the public.
- Requests for contested elections will be audited by the Dean of Campus Life and one member of the Student Government Association selected by the Advisors. The SGA member will be voted on and conferred by the Senate as their liaison.
- Only registered students may vote.
- All candidates must meet GPA requirements.
- No proxy or absentee ballots.
- Final interpretation of the elections and the election process will be at the discretion of the Dean of Campus Life Office.
- All rules and regulations are subject to change.

Appendix A: E-Board Structure

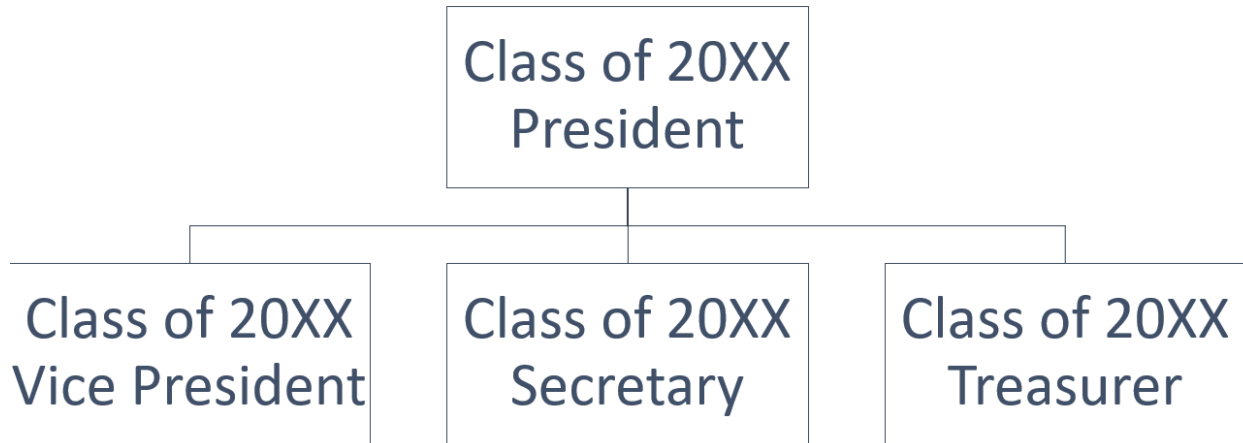
Executive Board
